Maldoror: (Les Chants de Maldoror) Jan 07 2022 This macabre but beautiful work, *Les Chants de Maldoror*, has achieved a considerable reputation as one of the earliest and most extraordinary examples of Surrealist writing. Thus, except for a few letters, it gives all the surviving literary work of Lautréamont.
